- Develop your understanding of gait analysis, biomechanical assessment, and orthotic prescription under the mentorship of experienced MSK podiatrists

- Assist with and develop skills in nail surgery under local anaesthetic, building confidence at your own pace under our lead surgical podiatrist.
- Carry out verruca treatments including Swift® microwave therapy
- Deliver high-quality routine podiatric care across dermatological and general nail presentations
- Learn to use shockwave therapy, laser, and other technologies.
- Contribute to a positive team culture and engage fully with CPD, training, and service development
